Celebrate Faithfulness This Jubilee Sunday

This coming Sunday is a church annual observance called "Jubilee Sunday." On this day the church honors those who have been members for 50 years or more and those who are 90 years old or older. I think this is a very significant event in the life of the church. It is important to demonstrate respect and honor to those who have been a vital part of our heritage. It is also important for us to learn from them. We live in changing times and may sometimes forget or overlook those basic and abiding truths and principles that are at the core of authentic faith.

I am not aware of how the title for this observance at First Baptist was first chosen. I assume it may have some connection to the Year of the Jubilee for the Jewish people which is detailed in the Old Testament. It is a rather complex set of guidelines and is found primarily in Leviticus 25 and 27. The Jubilee Year is the fiftieth year. The fifty years consist of seven Sabbatical Years, with the next year being the fiftieth (7 x 7 = 49 + 1 = 50). The Sabbatical Year, like the Sabbath Day, was to be a time of rest. It seems that the primary focus of rest was on the land. During that seventh year, the crops were not sown so that the land could rest. Then, in the fiftieth year, the Jubilee Year, Jewish slaves were to be freed, family property was to be returned to the original owners, and debts were to be cancelled. We have little information about how faithful the nation was to this plan but it does not seem to have been followed very closely. The purpose of such a plan seems to be an attempt to stimulate some effort toward a balance of fortunes. The foundational principle behind it was that the land and the people belong to the Lord.

If you are interested you might study Leviticus 25 and 27 for yourself. Meanwhile, come and enjoy Jubilee Sunday at First Baptist and share your appreciation for those whose faithfulness across the years has made a powerful contribution to the church's mission in the community and world.
